#### Director of Music

While familiarity with the Anglican form of service would be useful, passion, flexibility and an easy manner are more sought after qualities as is a willingness to develop a mix of both traditional and contemporary music.

The Director of Music's responsibilities are estimated to consume an average of 7-12 hours a week, contingent on the capabilities of the successful applicant.

- Accompaniment on our three manual Artisan Classic digital organ and Baldwin grand piano.
- Choral leadership. Our voluntary 4-part choir is small but capable. They view their work as a ministry, approaching it with dedication and lightheartedness and offer their time and talent out of their love for God and the enhancement of our worship.
- Planning and preparation of regular hymns, and service music, in collaboration with the Incumbent.
- Delivery of music at special events e.g. Christmas and Easter services.
- Managing budget, licensing requirements and overseeing the music library with timely communication to the music librarians.
- Ensuring that instruments are in good working order
- Contributing to the overall spirit and mirth of the church, its choir and congregation.

Our primary goal is gifted and inspiring choral direction. *If gifts as an organist are not as strong, we would be seeking additional assistance in the Organist role.*
